



Immersion France - Terms and Conditions and Booking Form

Deposit

A deposit of £150 is due with each booking. Once payment of your deposit had been made, you will receive your *Immersion France* confirmation of your booking.

Payment of Balance

Payment of the balance, as detailed in your *Immersion France* invoice, must reach us not later than SIX WEEKS before the start of the course. **We do not send out reminders.**

If you wish to cancel your course

The person who has signed the *Immersion France* booking form must give notice in writing to *Immersion France*, 30 Copley Park, London SW16 3DD. The cancellation will be deemed effective from the date of receipt of the letter by *Immersion France*. Our cancellation charges, based on the total cost of the course, are as follows:

More than 42 days before course starts	Deposit only
Between 41 & 29 days before course starts	33% of total cost
Between 28 & 7 days before course starts	75% of total cost
Less than 7 day before course starts	100% of total cost

Cancellation by *Immersion France*

We reserve the right to cancel a particular course due to circumstances beyond our control. In the unlikely event of this happening, we will make a full refund of all monies paid.

Personal comprehensive holiday insurance

We strongly recommend that you take out travel insurance covering Personal Accident, Emergency Medical and Associated Expenses, Cancellation Charges and Personal Liability.

Form E111

Your local Post office will give you a Form E111, which you should complete, validate and bring with you to France. You will then be eligible for treatment under the French National Health Service. Please note that a new form E111 will come into being on 1st January 2005 and your previous form will no longer be valid. Form E111 is not a substitute for personal, comprehensive holiday insurance.

£660 for the full 6 day intensive course which includes:

Accommodation - 6 Nights with 'host' family.

All your meals, including:

- ✓ Daily breakfast and dinner with your hosts (except as below)
- ✓ Working lunches - usually in the garden of the McAdoo's house in Rue St Martin
- ✓ Dinner in a Suèvres restaurant to enable you to sample local life
- ✓ Final repas communal on the last night

Tutoring - 6 days intensive tutoring + course materials (loose-leaf ring-binder, teaching handouts and notes, all stationery)

Excursions - regular trips to surrounding places of interest such as Le Château de Chambord or Le Château de Blois and the town of Blois itself.

Travel is not included but we will collect you from Mer railway stations and bring you to Suèvres by car, if you let us know which train you will be on, and we will return you to the station at the end of the course.

A typical timetable

Your week could look like the sample given below.

If you arrive during the afternoon you will immediately have the opportunity to become acquainted with your tutors and with other students before we take you to meet your host family. You will then have plenty of time to unpack, settle in with them, and explore the village before returning to our cottage for an aperitif; a welcoming dinner; and an introduction to the course.
